Co-option Notice - Parish Councillor Vacancies

Would you like to be a Parish Councillor?

Hulland Ward Parish Council currently has vacancies for 1 Parish Councillor.

The Parish Council intends to co-opt to fill this vacancy and invites interested persons to **email the Parish Clerk by not later than 5 pm on Friday 1 November 2024** formally declaring their willingness to be co-opted and why they wish to be considered.

To be eligible candidates must be 18 years or over and must in addition be either on the electoral roll of the parish or during the whole of the past 12 months have either lived in the parish, owned, or leased land in the Parish, have their main and only employment in the parish or within a 3-mile radius of it.

Candidates will be invited to the Council meeting on Monday 4 November 2024 and asked to address the Council for not more than 5 minutes. Following this, the Council will make a resolution co-opting the successful candidate, who will be required to sign a Declaration of Acceptance of Office and complete a Register of interests. The successful candidate will be expected to serve as a Councillor until the next elections in 2027.
